

Summary of 2025 Agrilnsurance Contract Changes

The following items are highlights of the changes made to the 2025 Agrilnsurance Contract*

Please refer to the Agrilnsurance Contract for full details of the changes. This is intended as a summary only and the clauses in the Agrilnsurance Contract will govern. This information is provided as required by the Agrilnsurance Contract insofar as it is a continuing contract with changes being made from year to year.

Birdsfoot trefoil has been added as an eligible crop for Forage Establishment Insurance.

The boundaries of Grain Corn Area 1 have been expanded, and the Grain Corn Insurance Test Area (ITA) is now part of Grain Corn Area 5.

The Hay Disaster Benefit trigger has increased from 20 to 30 per cent. If more than 30 per cent of insured forage producers in Manitoba produce less than 50 per cent of their probable yield, the Hay Disaster Benefit will trigger.
